Removing locked memory.dmp files after successful remediation

Symptoms

- Following successful remediation of the <u>Falcon content update BSoD</u>, the memory dump file is locked by the CSFalcon service
- The following error may be experienced when attempting to remove it, following remediation:
 - "The action can't be completed because the file is open in CrowdStrike Falcon Sensor Service"

Applies To

Remediation efforts related to <u>Tech Alert | Windows crashes related to Falcon Sensor |</u>
<u>2024-07-19</u>

Resolution

- Either of the following solutions are recommended to release this lock, allowing the file to be removed:
 - Restart the host and try deleting again restarting has been observed to release the sensor's lock on the dump file
 - Perform a repair, upgrade, or downgrade of the sensor: this will restart CSFalconService.exe, releasing the lock – see <u>Repairing Falcon Windows</u> <u>Sensors</u>

Resolution

• After remediation is complete, the memory dump file (usually located at *C:\Windows\memory.dmp*) can safely be removed from the system
